THE SUNDAY OF THE RESURRECTION, OR EASTER DAY

April 4, 2010

Welcome to St. Bede's Church. We're pleased that you have chosen to worship here today. If you are visiting, please sign the guest book or fill out the card in the Visitor's packet, and join the congregation downstairs in the parish hall for refreshments after the service. If you are unfamiliar with the ritual customs of the Episcopal Church, simply relax with the liturgy and let the rest of the congregation carry you in worship. The rest rooms, nursery and classrooms are located downstairs off the parish hall.

Today the church completes its three great days of celebrating redemption. Since Maundy Thursday, we have been involved in an extended liturgy which will be brought to its conclusion today. This is the celebration of the Passover of Christ from death into life. It is also the celebration of our own passover in Holy Baptism, in which "we were buried with Christ in his death and raised with him."

The Great Vigil of Easter is introduced on p. 1 of that service bulletin.

For the 10:00 a.m. service: Throughout the fifty days of Easter, the preferred first reading on Sundays is from the Acts of the Apostles rather than from the Old Testament. These weekly readings from Acts describe the life of the first Christians and their proclamation of Christ's resurrection. So today we hear a portion of the sermon Peter preached to Cornelius, the first Gentile Christian. The passage from Colossians reflects our share in the Resurrection, given us in Baptism. In Baptism we have died, and our life is now lived in Christ.

The Gospel reading is the account of the women at the tomb, when they learned that Jesus was risen. The women were told by the men (angels?) to tell the other disciples who were in hiding, but the other Gospels tell us that they met Jesus, who sent them to announce that he had risen.

As we rejoice in our new life in the risen Christ on this day, he comes among us and is made known to us in the breaking of the bread. We are sent forth to tell others of his resurrection.

Please feel free to join us in this celebration of God's victory over death. May you find in this gathering the assurance that God is even now raising you to new life.
