**W**elcome to St. Bede's Church. We're pleased that you have chosen to worship here today. If you are visiting, please sign the guest book or fill out the card in the Visitor's packet, and join the congregation downstairs in the parish hall for refreshments after the service. If you are unfamiliar with the ritual customs of the Episcopal Church, simply relax with the liturgy and let the rest of the congregation carry you in worship. The rest rooms, nursery and classrooms are located downstairs off the parish hall.

This is the beginning of the fifth week of celebrating the Resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ. Each Sunday in the fifty days between Easter and Pentecost we explore the implications of Jesus' dying and rising for our lives.

Today we hear from John's Gospel some of the Lord's words on the night before his death. The Lord tells his friends that he is going away and gives them his final instructions, "the new commandment" to love one another as he loves us.

This Sunday's reading from the book of Revelation is a vision of the new Jerusalem -- a holy city because God dwells in it indicating the intimate union of God with his chosen people.

Today's reading from Acts traces further the extension of the proclamation of Christ's resurrection. Last Sunday we heard of a miraculous healing in Joppa. Today the proclamation is one which clears the way to extend the message of the Risen Christ to the Gentiles.

It is in our relationship of union with Christ in Baptism and communion that his love for us is revealed. Our liturgy here equips us to carry out our larger liturgy -- our work as God's people -- in loving others through ministry, service, and prayer. In that way the work of extending God's kingdom will continue to spread in and through us, the Body of the risen Christ.
