NOAH ?!?

I am sure that no one has missed the fact that a new movie based on the Bible has burst on the scene this spring. This time, a biblically-based movie is being criticized by the fundamentalists. Why, because Noah is portrayed as being drunk (in the Bible), there is some sexual hanky-panky revolving around a son and his girl-friend (hey, with the world about to be destroyed, wouldn't you want to ensure your lineage?).

I have been questioned about non-Church friends about the story line? What were the sins that caused the destruction? Were they worse than sins that happened after the flood? Or today? What about “the Watchers” (remember the hymn, “Ye Watchers and ye Holy Ones”)? Were they really animated stone creatures? How does this story relate to other ancient flood sagas?

The Noah story line in the Bible is really thin; it runs from Gen 5.28—9.29. In Chpt. 6, the first four verses are almost like Greek mythology and seem out of place and unrelated to the rest of the story.

SO, our next **Wednesday night class** (7.40 pm) will be on the first 9 chapters of Genesis (Creation through Noah). It will commence on **April 30** and run for 8 weeks or until we are through the material. This is the first OT Class on the narrative books in quite a long time so I hope that you can come to all or part of it.. Just bring a Bible, you never know when we will actually read parts of it in class. Assignments: Read Genesis Chapter 1 by May 7.
