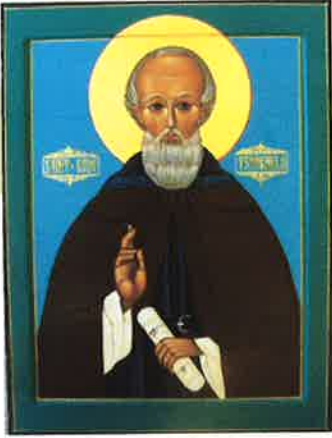

## MAY 25—A BIG DAY!!!



Our Bishop Suffragan the Rt. Rev. Diane Jardine Bruce will be with us on Sunday, May 25 as we celebrate our Patronal Festival. A bishop makes an official visitation to a parish at least every three years. The last Episcopal visitation was by Bp. Jon Bruno in June of 2013. This will be Bishop Diane's first visitation at St. Bede's. When the Bishop visits, she leads the worship, confirms/receives, etc., meets with the Vestry and oversees what her "mission station" in Mar Vista is doing and in what condition he finds it. Join us at 8 & 10 a.m. for worship to welcome the Bishop!!

## & WHY WE HAVE "THE LAYING ON OF HANDS"

In our Church, the Bishops confirm, receive (from other traditions) and pray over personal renewals ("reaffirmation"). They do all of those by what the BCP calls "The Laying-on-of-Hands". Bishops represent an unbroken line of people going back to the Twelve commissioned by Jesus in Matthew 28.18-20; we call that "Apostolic Succession." It is the role of the Bishop to "...guard the faith, unity, and discipline of the Church..." and to "...share in the leadership of the Church throughout the world." In the early Church, those set apart ("ordained") for ministry were Bishops ("episcopoi") and deacons ("diakonoi"). As the Church grew and more than one congregation was needed in an area, the Bishops set apart elders ("presbyteroi") to handle the sacramental actions for the bishop in those places.
