IS SUMMERTIME ORDINARY ?

♪♪ "Summertime, and the liturgy is ordinary ..." ♪♪

OK, I know that I have talked about this before, but we again find ourselves in what the Church calls "The Season after..." or, more commonly, "Ordinary Time." It is the six months of Green vestments that follow Trinity Sunday (i.e., the Sunday after Pentecost). It is 22 Sundays long only broken by the White of All Saints' Sunday on November 2nd this year.

I think some people were taught that to be a good Christian they should be at Church on Christmas, Easter and one other day. However, that is to be a statistically minimal Christian. We are asked to "work, pray and give for the spread of God's Kingdom." A great deal of that means loving God with our minds and we do that by hearing, reading and reflecting on God's Word in Holy Scripture. We are called to gather at God's Table for the Eucharist, "food for the journey" as it is called. How many of us only eat three times per year?

The Sunday readings during the summer tell us of great stories of the Old Testament — this year the patriarchs from Abraham through Moses; three Pauline Epistles — Romans, Philippians & 1st Thessalonians; and the great witness to Jesus in Matthew's Gospel. **No, its NOT ordinary at all!!!**
