A BIT OF HISTORY

I am often asked how our services developed. Obviously, the Episcopal Church's Book of Common Prayer (BCP) was developed from the Church of England's 1662 BCP. The English BCP was created from the Latin Mass books following the English reformation in the early 16th century. The Church of England had editions dated 1549, 1552, 1604 & 1662. The Episcopal Church has had four editions of the BCP: 1789, 1892, 1928 & 1979

Starting in July, one Sunday each month will feature a different liturgy from the Church's past as it was practiced in America. We will follow this schedule:

July 20: Church of England, 1662 BCP

August 10: Episcopal Church, 1789 BCP

September 14: Episcopal Church, 1892 BCP

October 12: Episcopal Church, 1928 BCP

We will examine the architecture of the Church as well as the "shape of the liturgy".
